MOUNTING METHOD Fix the safe in the place which is not easy to move • Drill holes for expansion bolts (or clamping screws) in the right place • Turn the expansion bolts counterclockwise to separate • Use the expansion bolts (or clamping screws) to secure the safe to the wall • Make sure the safe is mounted in place as required and then tighten all screws
